A WONDERFUL DAY AT ISRO - ISTRAC



Learning is not confined to classrooms and textbooks alone, it often comes alive through real-world experiences. With this vision in mind, our school, Sree Ayyappa Education Centre [CBSE], organized an exciting educational trip to ISRO - ISTRAC, Bengaluru, on 1st August 2025. The trip aimed to ignite curiosity and deepen scientific understanding among students by offering them an immersive, hands-on learning experience beyond the classroom walls.

The participants were warmly welcomed by Scientist B. Sankar Madaswamy and a lecture was delivered in the conference hall, where major mission decisions are taken by ISRO scientists. An overview of the history and achievements of ISRO, the types of satellites and their functions, and the causes and consequences of space debris was presented.

Live footages of significant missions such as Mangalyaan (2013), Aditya-L1 and the Chandrayaan missions were shown. The ISRO control centre - ISTRAC was explored and live coverage of the ongoing NISAR mission was observed.

The delegation was also accompanied by Mr. A.K. Anil Kumar, Director of ISRO-ISTRAC. The doubts of the participants were clarified by him and insights into ISRO's future missions were provided.




