

SAFAL is a diagnostic assessment that helps schools and teachers identify learning gaps at an early stage and improve teaching-learning methods. The results are not used for promotion but to support students' progress. Through SAFAL, CBSE aims to enhance the overall quality of education and ensure better learning for every child.

Aadhaar Enrolment and Updation Camp – 2025

An Aadhaar enrolment and updation camp was organised on our school premises on 24 November 2025, providing a convenient opportunity for parents and students to complete their Aadhaar-related services with ease.

Sukhoi SU-27 Aircraft Model by Class IX-D

Students of Class IX-D created an impressive model of the Russian fighter jet Sukhoi SU-27 Flanker. Built using thermocol, the model includes a 1400kv BLDC motor, 30A ESC, RGB receiver with CT6B transmitter and 9g micro servos. Although not designed to fly, the aircraft can move on land and is powered by an 11.1V lithium-polymer battery.

And flowers bloom all day long


The river glitters in light

of what moved through it moments ago.


A bird circles over the sky,
