


Proud Moment: Cadet Nivedya to Represent Karnataka & Goa at Republic Day Camp 2026

Teacher's Corner

TRICKS TO TACKLE MATHEMATICS CONFIDENTLY

1. Understand, Don't memorize.
2. Spend 30 minutes everyday solving a few problems.
3. Begin with simple examples to build confidence. Gradually move to medium and then tough questions.
4. Write all formulas topic-wise. Revise them frequently (especially before exams).
5. Always double - check units, positive/negative signs, and decimal points. Small mistakes cause big errors.
6. Never hesitate to ask your teacher or classmates if you don't understand something. Doubts left unclear grow into confusion later.
7. Start with the ones you are confident about - it boosts confidence and saves time.
8. Visual learning helps you understand patterns and relationships faster.
9. Don't mix topics.
10. When practicing, use a timer.
11. Discussing with friends helps you learn different methods to solve the same question.
12. Don't fear maths - treat it like a puzzle. Every mistake is a step closer to understanding. The more you practice, the more it starts to make sense.



Drenched in gold-n-gold


* He swapped out rings of time,
